Structure

1. Orientation

Who, when, where

Sometimes why and how

Optional: Explain complication - directly or implied.

2. Series of events

Main events - use time connectives and descriptive language

Event that causes complication - there may be more than one.

Evaluation - reaction by characters to complication(s).

3. Conclusion

Resolution - solution to the problem.

Optional: Lesson learnt from the story.
